ORDER


2. FGMK, LLC is awarded interim compensation in the amount of \$ 22,235.23 for services provided from April 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005. The Receiver is authorized to pay FGMK, LLC a total of \$ 22,235.23 from funds of the receivership estate in satisfaction of this award.

3. Pepper Hamilton LLP is awarded interim compensation in the amount of \$ 10,230.36 for services provided and expense reimbursement in the amount of \$ 679.25 for expenses incurred and advanced from April 1, 2005 through June 30, 2005. The Receiver is authorized to pay Pepper Hamilton LLP a total of \$ 10,909.61 from funds of the receivership estate in satisfaction of this award.
