Dear Judge Donio,

This a response to an order to show cause dated October 6, 2005 in the above-mentioned case. It is my intention to appear in court on November 2, 2005 at 2:00 p. m. and show cause why an order disallowing my claim in its entirety should not be entered. I will propound the following reasons why my investment differed from other investors that are being disallowed, disputed, or listed as a "tier two" investor.

1. Gregg Amerman introduced me to Tech Traders / Coyt Murray however; Coyt Murray himself advised me the proccedure to invest my money and the timeline when he would start "trading" my money.
2. Although I wired my money to Dream Venture Group, LLC c/o Gregg Amerman, Coyt Murray told me it was purely for "accounting purposes and to keep things legal." It has been speculated that Dream Venture Group, LLC, a.k.a. Gregg Amerman was an agent or pscudo partner in Tech Traders.
3. It is further been purported that Gregg Amerman / Dream Venture Group, LLC, was a co-conspirator in this scam for he recruited investors to invest either directly with Tech Traders or via Dream Venture Group, LLC, his words were "it does not matter to me how you invest."
4. By Amerman's admission, Coyt Murray has (at the least) a financial interest in Dream Venture Group, LLC, unlike other tier two investors. Additional dubious funds were co-mingled with Dream Venture Group, LLC, and Tech Traders making it one in the same therefore, I am a tier one investor.
5. Mr. Amerman's aberrant actions during the investigation and the interim distribution proceedings should be enough for this court to recognize that he should not be the liaison for my investment.

I look forward to the opportunity to appear and be heard.
