Dear Judge Donio,

This letter is to acknowledge that I am in receipt of the ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE in the Civil Action No: 04CV 1512 and that I plan to personally appear before your court on November 2, 2005 to show cause as to why my claim should not be disallowed.

It is my intention to show the court that the monies I contributed to Tech Traders should be viewed by the court as a direct loan to Tech Traders and not as a loan to Dream Venture Group rather that Dream Venture Group (DVG) was acting as a liaison between Tech Traders and investors who did not meet a minimum standard, set by Coyt Murray, to deal with Tech Traders directly. In addition, it is my intention to show that part of the monies received from Tech Traders to DVG, should not be considered as a distribution from Tech Traders to its investors but rather as payments made directly to DVG from Coyt Murray to purchase equity in the DVG suite of companies.

I appreciate the opportunity to appear before your court and anticipate a positive outcome for this unfortunate situation.
