ORDER

This matter comes before the Court upon the motions of Plaintiff, Commodity Futures Trading Commission, and Defendants, Tech Traders, Inc., Tech Traders, Ltd., Magnum Capital Investments, Ltd., Magnum Investments, Ltd. and Coyt E. Murray, seeking to strike the cross-claims of Defendants Equity Financial Group, LLC, Vincent J. Firth, and Robert W. Shimer (the "Equity Defendants"). By way of letter dated March 2, 2005, Samuel F. Abernethy, Esquire, counsel for the Equity Defendants, advised the Court that the Equity Defendants are withdrawing their cross-claims. Accordingly, the Court finds that the present motions to strike the cross-claims are moot.

ORDERED that the motions [130] and [131] to strike the crossclaims of the Equity Defendants shall be, and hereby are,

ORDERED that any party that seeks to amend its pleadings to assert additional claims, including cross-claims, or defenses, shall file a formal motion for leave to amend in accordance with Fed.R.Civ.P. 15 and L.Civ.R. 7.1(f), as amended by Order of Chief Judge John W. Bissell on February 24, 2005.
