I am opposed to expanding the daily limits that the Chicago Board of Trade has proposed for the major agricultural commodities.

Greater daily limits would increase the risk that we as farmer producers would face.

Greater margin risk would force smaller under capitalized elevators into financial difficulty and even failure.

Shutting down all months of a commodity for the remainder of the session could possibly stop cash grain for the day.

Do not allow the CBOT to expand their daily limits Thank you.
