I refer to the Advance Notice of Proposed Rule-making on CPO and CTA Registration Exemptions published in the Federal Register, Vol 67, No. 219 on Wednesday, November 13th, 2002.

The purpose of this email is to support the Managed Funds Association's Proposal.

I am a partner in the Financial Services Group of the international law firm Simmons & Simmons and am head of its hedge fund practice. We have been advising hedge fund sponsors and managers on the structure and establishment of hedge funds since 1983.
