In July 2003, respondent Bruce Miller (“Miller”) sought interlocutory review of an Administrative Law Judge’s (“ALJ”) order holding him in default for failing to file a timely answer. After the Division of Enforcement filed its opposition, Miller sought leave to withdraw his application. He explained that he intended to file a motion to set aside the default under Commission Rule 10.94 with the ALJ.

Accordingly, respondent Miller’s application for interlocutory review is dismissed.
