Former Commission registrant Joel J. Fetchenhier (“Fetchenhier”) has filed a *pro se* petition<sup>1</sup> seeking elimination of the remainder of the 10-year trading prohibition that the Commission imposed in October 1997.<sup>2</sup> The Commission reviews such petitions under the standards established in *In re LaCrosse*, [1999-2000 Transfer Binder] Comm. Fut. L. Rep. (CCH) ¶ 28,229 (CFTC Aug. 28, 2000).

The Office of Proceedings shall serve a copy of the petition on the Commission’s Division of Enforcement (“Division”) and the Division shall receive 30 days to respond to Fetchenhier’s petition.
