

Complainant Ya-Feng Wang ("Wang") seeks reconsideration of a delegated authority order issued September 30, 2004, denying his second motion for an extension of time to file an appeal brief. *See* Commission Regulation 12.408(c). Upon review of relevant documents, we have determined to grant Wang an additional two weeks from the date this order is issued.¹ If Wang continues to lack access to a computer, as he has stated in all of his submissions seeking relief from the filing deadline, he may submit a handwritten document.² We remind Wang that he has been granted leave to file an informal document in lieu of a brief. *See* Commission Regulation 12.401(d). Wang shall file and serve his brief in accordance with this order.
