

Armando T. Belly is General Counsel of Soros Fund Management LLC. Mr. Belly was born in Trenton, New Jersey in 1946. He attended the University of Pittsburgh from 1964-1968 where he was a William Pitt Scholar. Mr. Belly graduated in 1968 with a degree in Political Science. He taught third and fourth grade in the New York City public school system before attending New York University School of Law where he was Articles Editor of the Annual Survey of American Law.
