Mr. Crapple is Co-Chief Executive Officer and Co-Chairman of Millburn Ridgefield Corporation and The Millburn Corporation, and a partner of ShareInVest Research Limited Partnership.

In 1966 he graduated with honors from the University of Wisconsin where his field of concentration was economics and he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa. In 1969 he graduated from Harvard Law School, magna cum laude, where he was a member of the Harvard Law Review.
