ORDER OF DESIGNATION

The New Orleans Commodity Exchange ("NOCE") having submitted, pursuant to section 6 of the Commodity Exchange Act ("Act"), 7 U.S.C. §8 (Supp. III 1979), a request for contract market designation to trade futures contracts in milled, long-grain rice, and the Commodity Futures Trading Commission having reviewed this request pursuant to the authority vested in the Commission by the Act, 7 U.S.C. §1 et seq. (1976), as amended by the Futures Trading Act of 1978, Pub. L. No. 95-405, 92 Stat. 865 (Supp. III 1979),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, under section 5 of the Act, 7 U.S.C. §7 (1976), the application of the NOCE for designation as a contract market shall be and is granted for the following commodity: milled, long-grain rice; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this grant of designation shall be subject in particular to sections 5, 5a, 5b, 6, 6a, 6b, 8a(7), 8a(9) and 8c of the Act, 7 U.S.C. §§7, 7a, 7b, 8, 10a, 13a, 12a(7), 12a(9) and 12c (1976 and Supp. III 1979), and to compliance in all other respects with the requirements applicable to the NOCE as a board of trade under the Act.
