The Exchange certifies that this regulatory advisory neither violates nor is inconsistent with any provision of the Commodity Exchange Act or of the rules and regulations thereunder.

**514. TRADING INFRACTIONS**

Charges shall be issued and hearings shall be conducted for violations of this rule in accordance with Rule 409.

**514.A. Definition**

The following shall constitute trading infractions:

[1 through 5 are unchanged.]

6. use of profane, obscene or unbusinesslike language on the trading floor;

7. use of undue force while in, entering or leaving the pittrading floor;
