CONCISE EXPLANATION AND ANALYSIS OF THE OPERATION, PURPOSE, AND EFFECT OF
THE PROPOSED RULE AND ITS COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE
ACT, INCLUDING CORE PRINCIPLES AND THE COMMISSION’S REGULATIONS
THEREUNDER

Eurex Clearing is amending the Clearing Conditions to reflect the decision of Management Board of Eurex Deutschland and the Executive Board of Eurex Zürich to introduce FX futures and options on six currency pairs (AUD/USD, AUD/JPY, EUR/AUD, USD/JPY, and NZD/USD). Eurex Clearing will offer clearing services for these contracts. In addition, changes are being made to existing currency pairs to reduce the minimum block trade size and allocate the currency pairs into individual Product Assignment Groups.

Further information regarding the operation, purpose, and effect of the proposed amendments is discussed in the attached Eurex Clearing Circular 095/16, which is appended as Attachment A.

Eurex Clearing has identified the following derivatives clearing organization (“DCO”) Core Principle as potentially being relevant to the above amendments:

1. DCO Core Principle C (Participant and Product Eligibility): The amendments will comply with DCO Core Principle C because the amendments list new contracts and make amendments to certain existing products. All products listed on Eurex Exchange and cleared by Eurex Clearing will continue to be subject to appropriate standards in compliance with this Core Principle.
