Re: Certification Pursuant to Commission Rule 40.6 – Rule Amendments (SwapEx CFTC Submission #09.15)

Dear Ms. Jurgens:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c) of the Commodity Exchange Act (the “Act”) and Section 40.6(a) of the regulations of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (the “CFTC” or “Commission”), SwapEx, LLC (“SwapEx”, or the “Company”) hereby notifies the Commission that it has amended its Rulebook and that it is certifying those amendments. The Rulebook has been amended in response to questions, comments and guidance from the Commission. The amended Rulebook will become effective on December 30, 2015.

In addition, SwapEx previously submitted self-certification filings on the following three advisory notices that were submitted to the CFTC as rules and are now also being amended:

Advisory Notice 01-15-SwapEx Trading Procedures and Protocols;

Advisory Notice 02-15 (Credit Risk Filter Functionality); and


Advisory Notice 03-15 (Block Trade Functionality)

These advisory notices similarly are being amended in response to questions, comments and guidance from the Commission.

A concise explanation of the amendments to the Rulebook and their compliance with applicable provisions of the Act, including core principles and the Commission’s regulations, is attached hereto as Exhibit A. A clean copy of the amended Rulebook is attached hereto as Exhibit B, and a copy of the Rulebook marked to show changes against the version submitted to the Commission as part of the Rule certification on September 4, 2015, is attached hereto as Exhibit C. SwapEx hereby certifies that: (i) the amended Rulebook complies with the Act and the Commission’s regulations thereunder, and (ii) a notice and copy of this submission is being concurrently posted on SwapEx’s web site. There were no substantive opposing views to the amendments to the Rulebook.
