Dear Mr. Kirkpatrick:

New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“NYMEX” or “Exchange”) is notifying the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) that it is self-certifying amendments to the NYMEX Position Limit, Position Accountability and Reportable Level Table (the “Table”) located in the Interpretations and Special Notices Section of Chapter 5 of the NYMEX Rulebook in order to correct the aggregation allocation of the European Low Sulphur Gasoil Brent Crack Spread Average Price Option contract (the “Contract”) (commodity code 3U; product chapter 710A), effective on Thursday, March 24, 2016.

More specifically, the low sulphur gasoil leg (“Leg 1”) of the Contract is set to aggregate into an incorrect underlying futures contract. This amendment is intended to rectify the aggregation allocation of Leg 1 of the Contract such that Leg 1 shall appropriately aggregate into the European Low Sulphur Gasoil Financial Futures contract (commodity code GX; product chapter 728). As such, the Table will be amended to reflect (i) the correct aggregation allocation for Leg 1, (ii) the correct aggregate into ratio, (iii) the spot month limit, single month and all month levels for the correct parent contract (Leg 1). The aggregation allocation for Leg 2 of the Contract shall remain unchanged. There currently is no open interest in the Contract.

The amended Table is set forth in Appendix A (under separate cover), with additions underscored and deletions ~~overstruck~~.

The Exchange reviewed the designated contract market core principles (“Core Principles”) as set forth in the Commodity Exchange Act (“Act”) and identified that the amendments to the Table may have some bearing on the following Core Principle:

Availability of General Information: On the business eve of the effective date, the Exchange shall amend the Table in the online rulebook to reflect the corrected aggregation allocation for Leg 1 of the Contract.

The Exchange certifies that the amendments to the Table comply with the Act and regulations thereunder. There were no opposing views to the amendments to the Table.
