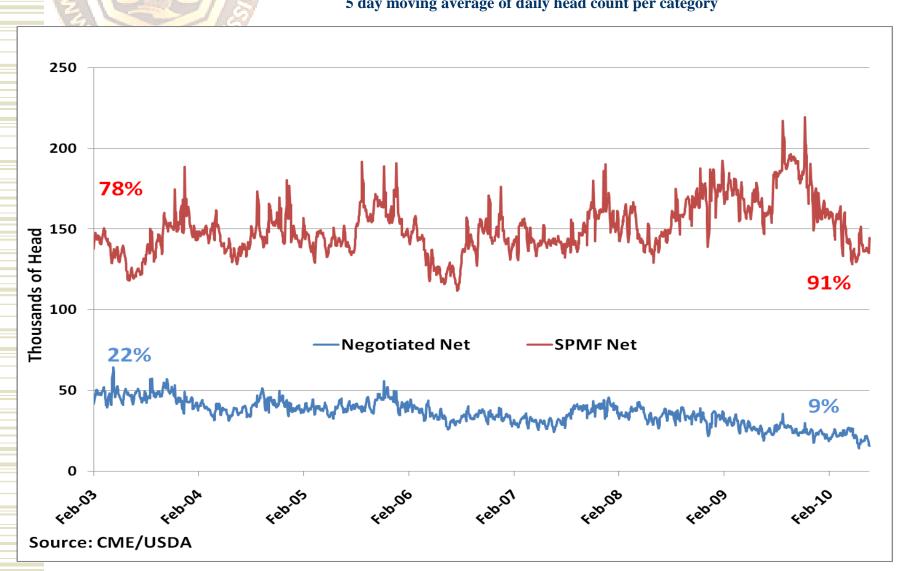

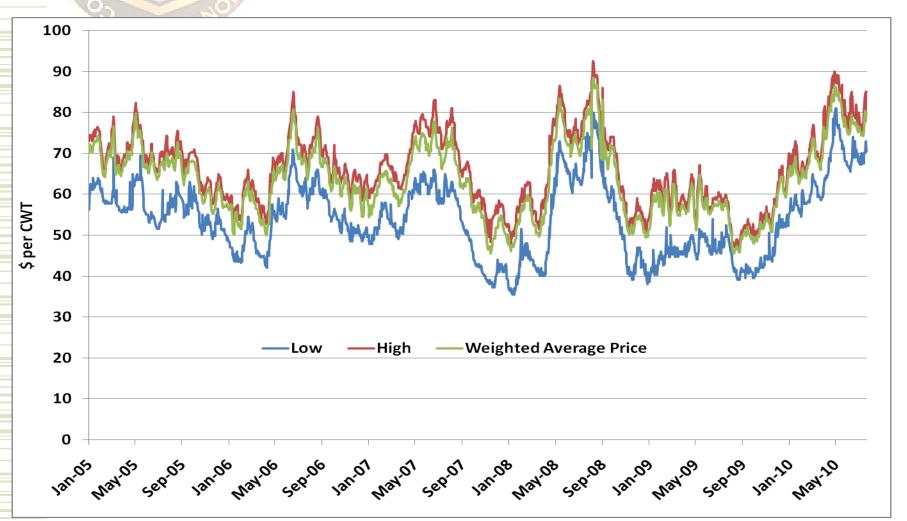

5 day moving average of daily head count per category



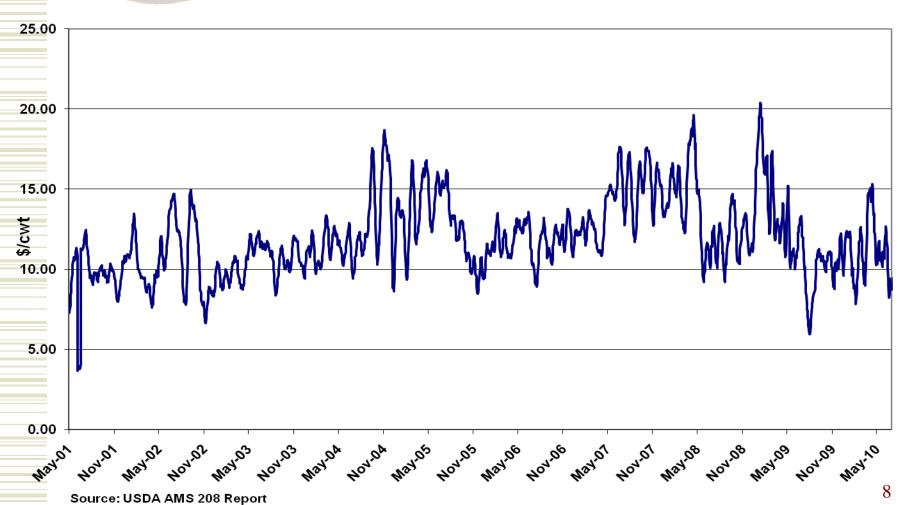
#### Weighted Average Negotiated Base Price Range Western Corn Belt – 212 Report, carcass



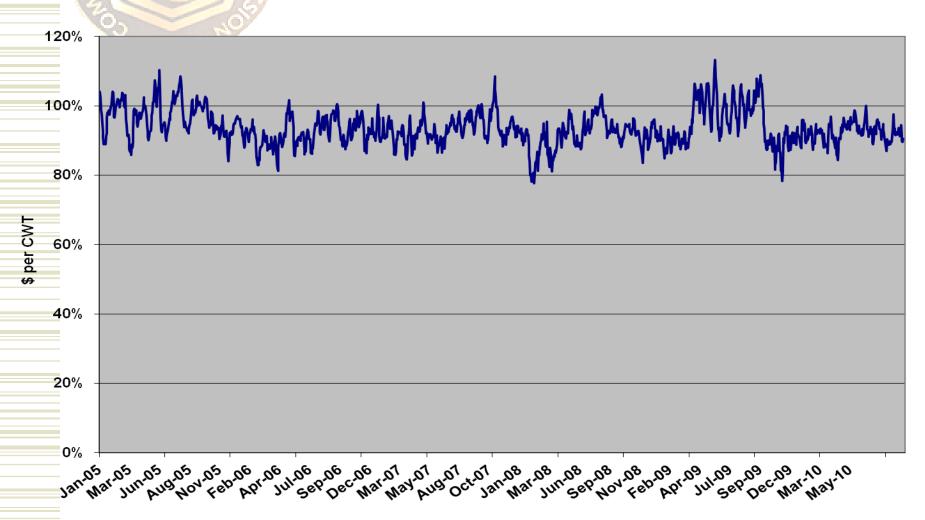


#### Weighted Average Negotiated Base Price Range

Western Corn Belt – 10 day moving average



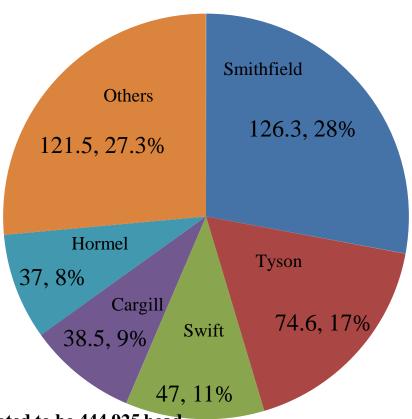
## Western Corn Belt Weighted Average Carcass Price As a Percentage of the Carcass Cutout
