This matter came before the Court on Plaintiff Commodity Futures Trading

Commission's ("CFTC" or "Commission") Motion to Strike the unauthorized Sur-reply filed by Defendant Robert V. Shimer pursuant to letter to the Court dated June 23, 2006. This Sur-reply was not filed in proper format as a Sur-reply. It also was filed in violation of L.Civ.R.7.1(d)(6), which provides that "[n]o sur-replies are permitted without permission of the Judge or Magistrate Judge to whom the case is assigned." Shimer did not seek permission of this Court to file his Sur-reply. Therefore, the CFTC's Motion to Strike Shimer's Unauthorized Sur-Reply is GRANTED.
