On December 6, 1935, the Secretary of Agriculture issued a complaint charging the respondents with refusal to permit a Department employee to examine futures records relating to grain trading covering the period from December 1, 1932, through October 30, 1935.

A hearing was held before a referee at Minneapolis, Minnesota, on December 16, 1935. In view of the decision of the United States Supreme Court in the Cutten case (GFA Docket No. 7), the Grain Futures Commission dismissed the complaint on September 12, 1936
