Complaint and Notice of Hearing Under the Commodity Exchange Act
There is reason to believe that respondent Rawlin L. Stovall has violated the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended, (7 U.S.C. 1 et seq.) hereinafter referred to as the Act and that Stovall and Stovall, Inc. is unfit to engage in the business of futures commission merchant. This complaint and notice of hearing is issued under the provisions of sections 6(b) and (c) and 8a(3) of the Act (7 U.S.C. 9, 13b and 12a(3)), stating the charges as follows:

## I

a. Rawlin L. Stovall, hereinafter referred to as Stovall, an individual whose business address is Room 2014, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60604, is now and was at all times material herein a registered floor broker under the Act, a member of the Chicago Board of Trade and a member of the Chicago Open Board of Trade (now known as the MidAmerica Commodity Exchange.) Stovall is now and was at all times herein the
president and principal stockholder of Stovall and Stovall, Inc. At all times material herein, Stovall was doing business under the name R. L. Stovall, Sole Proprietor, Principal in Cash Commodities.
b. Stovall and Stovall, Inc., an Illinois corporation with its principal office and place of business at Room 2014, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60604, is now and was at all times material herein a registered futures commission merchant under the Act.

II
The Chicago Board of Trade and the Chicago Open Board of Trade (now known as the MidAmerica Commodity Exchange) are now and were at all times material herein boards of trade and duly designated contract markets under the Act.

III
The transactions referred to herein, if executed, could have been used for hedging transactions in interstate commerce in such commodities or the products or byproducts thereof, or for determining the price basis of transactions in interstate commerce in such commodities or for delivering such commodities sold, shipped or received in interstate commerce for the fulfillment thereof.

During the period from about May 3, 1972, to about December 6, 1972, respondent Stovall engaged in a course of business in which he solicited and accepted orders which he represented to be for contracts for the purchase and sale of cash commodities. Such orders were actually for contracts for the purchase and sale of commodities for future delivery. In connection with such orders, Stovall demanded and received cash deposits to margin, guarantee or secure such transactions. At no time during such period, was Stovall or R. L. Stovall, Sole Proprietor, Principal in Cash Commodities, registered as a futures commission merchant under the Act.

V
From time to time during the period alleged in paragraph IV, Stovall delivered and caused to be transmitted through the mails documents which purported to confirm the execution of the orders described in paragraph IV. Transactions so reported to customers as having been executed for such customers' accounts included, but were not limited to, those set forth in Annex A which is attached to and is a part of this complaint. Documents so used included, but were not limited to, that shown in Annex $B$ which is attached to and is a part of this complaint.

VI
The transactions confirmed to customers as described in paragraph V were not executed but rather were bucketed, Stovall himself taking the opposite side of each customer's order with no intention of bona fide execution.

## VII

On December 20, 1972, Stovall failed and refused and continues to fail and refuse to make his records concerning the course of business described in paragraph IV and the reported transactions described in paragraphs V and VI available for inspection by representatives of the United States Department of Agriculture.

## VIII

By reason of the facts alleged herein:
a. Respondent Stovall willfully violated sections 4, 4b(D), 4c(A), and 4d(1) of the Act (7 U.S.C. 6, 6b(D), 6c(A), 6d(1)) and sections 1.35(a) and 1.38(a) of the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture thereunder (17 CFR 1.35(a), 1.38(a)).
b. Respondent Stovall and Stovall, Inc. is unfit to engage in the business of futures commission merchant as contemplated by section 8a(3) of the Act (7 U.S.C. 12a(3)).

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that this complaint and notice of hearing be served upon the respondents and this proceeding
shall be governed by sections $0.1,0.2,0.4(\mathrm{~b}), 0.5$ through 0.22 and 0.28 of the rules of practice under the Commodity Exchange Act (17 CFR 0.1, 0.2, 0.4(b), 0.5 through $0.22,0.28$ ). The respondents will have twenty (20) days after the receipt of this complaint in which to file with the Hearing Clerk, United States Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C. 20250, an answer with an original and five copies, fully and completely stating the nature of the defense and admitting or denying, specifically and in detail, each allegation of this complaint. Allegations not answered will be deemed admitted for the purposes of this proceeding. Failure to file an answer will constitute an admission of all the allegations of this complaint and a waiver of hearing. The filing of an answer in which all of the material allegations of fact contained in the complaint are admitted likewise shall constitute a waiver of hearing unless a hearing is requested. The respondents are hereby notified that unless hearing is waived, a hearing will be held in Chicago, Illinois, at a place therein and
date to be specified later, before a referee designated to conduct such hearing. At such hearing, the respondents will have the right to appear and show cause, if any there be, why an appropriate order should not be issued in accordance with the Commodity Exchange Act, (1) suspending or revoking the registration of
respondent Rawlin L. Stovall as a floor broker, (2) suspending or revoking the registration of respondent Stovall and Stovall, Inc. as a futures commission merchant, (3) prohibiting respondent Stovall from trading on or subject to the rules of any contract market, and directing that all contract markets refuse all trading privileges to respondent Stovall for such period of time as may be determined and (4) directing that respondent Stovall shall cease and desist from violating the Act in the manner alleged herein.

It is ordered that this complaint and notice of hearing be served on the respondents at least twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.
