Complaint and Notice of Hearing Under Section 6(b) of the Commodity Exchange Act

There is reason to believe that the respondents named herein have violated the Commodity Exchange Act (7 U.S.C. 1 et seq.), hereinafter referred to as the Act, and the regulations made pursuant thereto (17 CFR, Part I). In accordance with the provisions of section 6(b) of the Act (7 U.S.C. 9), this complaint and notice of hearing is issued stating the charges in that respect as follows:

The Chicago Board of Trade is now and was at all times material to this complaint a duly designated contract market under the Act.

ΙI

Respondent Robert E. Willey, an individual whose business address is Room 1502, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois, is now and was at all times material to this complaint a registered floor broker under the Act and a member of the Chicago Board of Trade.

III

Respondent Earle M. Combs III, an individual whose business address is Room 1502, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois, is now and was at all times material to this complaint a member of the Chicago Board of Trade.

Respondent Richard A. Frymire, an individual whose business address is Room 1388, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois, is now and was at all times material to this complaint a registered floor broker under the Act and a member of the Chicago Board of Trade.

Respondent Howard S. Fisher, an individual whose business address is Room 1632, 141 West Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois, is now and was at all times material to this complaint a registered floor broker under the Act and a member of the Chicago Board of Trade.

The transactions specified in this complaint were in wheat and soybean futures and were entered into on or subject to the rules of the Chicago Board of Trade. At all times material herein wheat and soybean futures on the Chicago Board of Trade were traded in job lot units of 1,000 bushels and in round lot units of 5,000 bushels.

Frymire, during the period from May 21, 1965, through February 28, 1966, entered into transactions as specified in the tabulation below, which transactions were wash sales or were of the character of wash sales. The transactions in wheat and soybean futures specified in [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] agraphs VII and VIII hereof, were capable of being used for (1) [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] ging a transaction in interstate commerce in wheat or soybeans, [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] pectively, or the products or by-products thereof, or (2) deter[ILLEGIBLE TEXT] ing the price basis of a transaction in interstate commerce in [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] at or soybeans, respectively, or (3) delivering wheat or soybeans, [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] pectively, sold, shipped, or received in interstate commerce.

By reason of the facts alleged in this complaint the respondents: [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] entered into transactions which were, or were of the character [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] wash sales and fictitious sales, in wilful violation of section of the Act (7 U.S.C. 6c); and (2) executed purchases and sales commodities for future delivery in a manner which was not open [ILLEGIBLE TEXT] competitive, in wilful violation of section 1.38 of the regula[ILLEGIBLE TEXT]ons (17 CFR 1.38).

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that this complaint and notice hearing be served upon the said respondents. The respondents [ILLEGIBLE TEXT]11 have twenty (20) days after the receipt of this complaint in [ILLEGIBLE TEXT]ch to file with the Hearing Clerk, United States Department of [ILLEGIBLE TEXT]iculture, Washington, D. C. 20250, an answer with an original five copies, fully and completely stating the nature of the [ILLEGIBLE TEXT]se and admitting or denying, specifically and in detail, each

allegation of this complaint. Allegations not answered will be deemed admitted for the purposes of this proceeding. Failure to file an answer will constitute an admission of all the allegations of this complaint and a waiver of hearing. The filing of an answer in which all of the material allegations of fact contained in the complaint are admitted likewise shall constitute a waiver of hearing unless a hearing is requested. The respondents are hereby notified that unless hearing is waived, a hearing will be held at 10:00 a.m., local time, on March 7, 1967, in Chicago, Illinois, at a place therein to be specified later, before a referee designated to conduct such hearing. At such hearing, the respondents will have the right to appear and show cause, if any there be, why an order should not be made suspending or revoking the registrations of respondents Robert E. Willey, Richard A. Frymire and Howard S. Fisher as floor brokers, and directing that all contract markets refuse all trading privileges to each respondent for such period of time as may be determined.

It is ordered that this complaint and notice of hearing be served on each of the said respondents at least twenty (20) days prior to the date set for hearing.
