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**ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING**

On August 4, 2000, the parties filed a written stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). See Stipulation Of Voluntary Dismissal, filed August 4, 2000 ("Stipulation"). In the Stipulation, they requested that prior to dismissing the case, the Court stay the proceeding until August 30, 2000, to permit the parties to fully perform their underlying settlement agreement. Id. The Court granted the request. See Order Staying Proceeding, filed August 4, 2000.

The Court's August 4, 2000 Order stated that if no party requested further proceedings by August 30, 2000, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. See 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
