ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Having settled this matter last January, the parties filed a stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). See Notice of Settlement and Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice, filed January 18, 2001. They requested, however, that the proceeding be stayed until October 1, 2001, to permit full performance of their settlement agreement prior to dismissal of the complaint. Id. The Court granted the stay, stating that it would dismiss the case if no party requested further proceedings by October 1. See Order Staying Proceeding, dated January 19, 2001. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. See 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
