ORDER OF DISMISSAL

During lengthy negotiations mediated by the Judgment Officer, complainant and respondents entered into an oral agreement to settle their case. Both sides have asked that this Order of Dismissal reflect the terms of the settlement so that both sides are fully protected in the future.

The terms of the settlement, as explicitly discussed with both sides, were as follows: In exchange for a payment of \$1,000 (by money order or cashier's check) made to complainant by respondents no later than September 15, 2000, and for the acceptance of that payment by complainant, both sides have agreed to waive and dismiss with prejudice any and all claims, under any statute or provision of law in this or any other forum, either side may have arising out of complainant's account that is the subject of this proceeding.

Respondents sent the payment by certified mail to complainant in the form of a money order on August 16, and complainant signed for delivery of that payment on August 18, 2000. Accordingly, the terms of the settlement are fulfilled and therefore there is no remaining dispute between the parties. As a result, the proceeding must be, and hereby is, **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
