**DEFAULT ORDER**

Respondents Blue Sky Capital Management Corporation and Gregory Michael Schneider have failed to file answers and thus are in default. By defaulting, respondents are deemed to have admitted the allegations in the complaint. Accordingly, it is concluded that Blue Sky Capital Management Corporation and Gregory Michael Schneider violated Section 4o(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act and that this violation caused \$8,831.84 in damages, and Blue Sky Capital Management Corporation and Gregory Michael Schneider are ORDERED to pay to John M. Istele reparations of \$8,831.84, plus pre-judgment interest on that amount at 0.35% compounded annually from June 28, 2007, to the date of payment, plus \$125 in costs for the filing fee. Liability is joint and several.
