

Order of Dismissal for Cause

By Order issued March 26, 1998, complainant was directed to respond further to discovery requests served on him by respondent Lind-Waldock. There was no compliance with that Order and, on April 15, 1998, complainant was Ordered to Show Cause why judgment should not be entered in favor of respondent. Complainant was informed that any response to the Order had to be accompanied by a showing that he had complied with the terms of the Order issued March 26, 1998.
