**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

Respondent Otto Feddern has produced a copy of Victor Lyons' petition under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code, filed March 3, 2011, in the Western District of Washington of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, pursuant to CFTC rule 12.24, the default order dated March 16, 2011 as to Victor Lyons is vacated and the complaint against Victor Lyons is dismissed without prejudice.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> My office forwarded to the complainants a copy of Feddern's submission, which he had not served on them. Feddern is reminded that, each time that he files a submission with the CFTC Proceedings Clerk, he should serve a copy of that submission on the Schweickarts, and he should include with his submission a written confirmation that he has done so.

<sup>2</sup> The office of the Bankruptcy Trustee has confirmed that the bankruptcy petition filed by Victor Lyons relates solely to Lyons in his individual capacity and does not apply to the firm Aramis Capital Management. Accordingly, the default order as to Aramis remains in effect and has become a final order of the Commission.
