
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Having settled this matter, complainants James E. and Sharon A. Warn and respondents FSG International, Incorporated and Richard Michael Rosengarten filed a written stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). Stipulation of Dismissal, filed July 31, 1998. The settlement agreement, submitted in camera, provided for an initial payment to complainants followed by additional payments over the next 60 days. Accordingly, the Court issued an order staying this proceeding to ensure performance under the terms of the agreement. Order Staying Proceedings and Canceling The Oral Hearing, dated July 31, 1998.

The Court's July 31, 1998 Order stated that if none of the parties requested further proceedings on or before October 28, 1998, the Court would enter the an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the Complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
