

ORDER


And now upon consideration of the Agreement of the parties and in accordance with their Agreement the following Order is hereby entered:

1. An award is made in favor of Irving Wolovsky and against Richard L. Jones in the sum of \$7,600.
2. The award shall be paid as follows:
 - a. \$4,000 by certified check or equivalent to the order of Irving Wolovsky and Lewis H. Markowitz, his attorney.
 - b. Commencing on June 1, 1999, and on the 1st of each and every month thereafter for the next 18 months a certified check or equivalent in the amount of \$200 payable to Irving Wolovsky and Lewis H. Markowitz, his attorney.
 - c. The provisions of 17 CFR Part 12, §12.407(c) shall be incorporated by reference and it shall be the duty of the Respondent Richard L. Jones to comply with the terms to avoid automatic suspension as so provided.
 - d. Upon payment of the final installment the Petitioner Irving Wolovsky will submit a release in such form as shall be required by

Richard L. Jones and the matter shall be noted as finally settled on the docket of the Commission.

This Order shall be deemed the final Order of the Commission and in accordance with the understanding of the parties, it is noted on the record that any right to appeal by either party has been waived.
