



U.S. COMMODITY FUTURES TRADING COMMISSION

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Statement of the Commission

June 14, 2010

I. Introduction

The Commission is issuing this letter to approve the contracts of Media Derivatives, Inc. (MDEX or Exchange) with specific modifications requested by the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC or Commission) to guard against manipulation or any other abusive conduct in the trading of any contract by knowledgeable and informed sources within the studio or distribution company.

In correspondence dated March 9, 2010, MDEX¹ requested Commission review and approval of the Opening Weekend Motion Picture Revenue futures and binary option contracts on the motion picture *Takers*. The request was made pursuant to Section 5c(c)(2) of the Commodity Exchange Act (CEA or Act) and Commission Regulation 40.3.

Section 5c(c)(3) of the Act requires the Commission to “approve any such new contract or instrument ... unless the Commission finds that the new contract or instrument...would violate this Act.” After extensive review and after CFTC staff and MDEX agreed to additional safeguards, the Commission does not believe that the terms and conditions of the proposed Weekend Motion Picture Revenue futures and options contracts violate the Act or the Commission’s Regulations thereunder.

In making this determination, the Commission found that the contracts are based on commodities, are not readily susceptible to manipulation and serve an economic hedging purpose.²

Accordingly, we are issuing a letter approving the contracts.

II. Box Office Revenues Are a “Commodity” Subject to the Commission’s Jurisdiction

The CEA grants the Commission exclusive jurisdiction over contracts of sale of a “commodity” for future delivery and over transactions in “commodity” options that are traded on a designated contract market. Thus, an initial question for review of a futures or options contract traded on a DCM is whether the underlying subject of the contract is a commodity.³ With the attached letter, the Commission has found that box office revenues are a “commodity” as generally defined by section 1a(4) of the CEA.

In addition to certain enumerated agricultural commodities, Section 1a(4) provides that “all services, rights, and interests in which contracts for future delivery are presently or in the future dealt in” are statutory commodities. The 1974 Act extended the Commission’s exclusive jurisdiction to “all futures trading that might now exist or might develop in the future.”⁴ By broadly defining the term commodity, the Commission believes that Congress intended for the CFTC to regulate futures and options on “all commodities, goods, articles, services, rights, and interests which are or may be the subject of futures contracts.”⁵

Movie revenues fall into the same category as many other commodities for which futures and options contracts have been either approved by or self-certified to the Commission where the underlying commodity is a non-price-based measure of an economic activity, commercial activity or environmental event. The underlying commodity may not be directly traded, so there is no cash market for the commodity, but the commodity reflects some measure of economic activity or event that can be used for a hedging purpose when incorporated into a futures or options contract.

The Commission has found that such a commodity is a right or interest within the meaning of section 1(a)(4). While the right or interest may be intangible, it can clearly serve as the basis for a futures or options contract. More than 500 of these types of contracts have been approved by or self-certified to the Commission to date. Examples of these types of contracts (see Appendix I for a comprehensive list) are: Company-Specific Earnings Per Share; Eurozone Index of Consumer Prices; Consumer Price Index; Nonfarm Payrolls; Retail Sales Data; Unemployment Claims; Company-Specific Merger and Acquisitions; State-Specific and National Crop Yields; Location-Specific Heating and Cooling Degree Days; Location-Specific Snowfall; and Regional Wind Indices.

Movie revenues are the basis for a multi-billion dollar industry. A right or interest in movie revenue events is little different from a right or interest in a company's earnings per share, a merger and acquisition between two companies, the release of major economic indicators or other events with economic or commercial significance.

A question has arisen as to whether an underlying cash market for a commodity must exist under section 1a(4). Neither the statutory text nor legislative history of the various Acts

fact question, and that "there is no evidence that West Coast gas could not in the future be traded on a futures exchange.").

that have established or amended the CEA since 1974 suggest that Congress intended to limit statutory commodities to commodities for which there is an underlying cash market. In fact, the statutory text of the CEA suggests otherwise. For example, section 1a(13)(ii) of the Act defining “excluded commodities” mentions “measure of economic or commercial risk, return or value” that may be “based solely on 1 or more commodities that have no cash market.”

For these reasons, the Commission does not believe that the existence of an underlying cash market is a requirement for meeting the definition of a commodity within section 1a(4) of the Act.

We also address the question of whether or not movie revenue contracts are event contracts. The term “event” contract has no meaning under the Act. More than 500 contracts have already been submitted to the Commission that are based on some type of event or activity with economic consequences. The statutory definition of “commodity” does not suggest that an “event” cannot underlie a futures or options contract. Thus, that a contract is based on an event does not preclude it from being a commodity under section 1(a)(4).

Accordingly, the Commission believes that movie revenues meet the definition of a commodity under section 1a(4).

III. The Contract is Not Readily Susceptible to Manipulation

Of paramount concern to the Commission is whether this contract is susceptible to manipulation either (1) through trading behavior or (2) by using or manipulating privileged or insider information by certain studio or distribution company officials. Under Core Principle 3 as established in section 5(d) of the Act, to maintain its standing, a designated contract market is required to list “only contracts that are not readily susceptible to manipulation.” The Commission staff insisted on specific modifications to the original contract proposal to ensure that knowledgeable parties cannot intentionally release or misreport data that would have an

impact on the trading or settlement of this contract. The Commission will not tolerate manipulation or any other abusive conduct in the trading of any contract. We believe the terms and conditions adequately address concerns about the susceptibility of the contracts to manipulation.

A. The Rentrak Numbers Used for Cash Settlement of the Contract are not Readily Susceptible to Manipulation

Cash settlement is a method of settling futures or option contracts whereby, at contract expiration, a cash payment is made between the long (*buyer*) and short (*seller*) traders reflecting the amount of profit or loss on the traders' positions, based upon a procedure specified in the contract. While cash settlement mitigates concerns about market congestion that may be present in physical delivery contracts, cash-settled contracts still may be vulnerable to manipulation or price distortion. The Commission is satisfied that the revenue numbers used by these contracts to determine settlement should minimize the potential for manipulation.

The cash settlement price is derived from revenue numbers collected by Rentrak Corporation and disseminated throughout the industry. Rentrak is a third-party data aggregator and conduit that has no direct monetary interest in any motion picture. Its relevant function focuses on transferring motion picture revenue data from the theaters to the distributors.

According to staff communications with Rentrak and MDEX, since 2008, Rentrak has, on average, collected more than 98 percent of motion picture revenues from theaters with 95 percent of data on ticket purchases transferred automatically and directly from the theaters to Rentrak. The remaining numbers are reported to Rentrak via a daily e-mail or fax. Rentrak transmits the point-of-sale data to distributors and, according to Rentrak's website, to its subscribers (which include competing distributors) on a daily and near real-time basis.

Compilation of the data is predominately automated so that there is little opportunity for misrepresentation or distortion of the numbers reported to Rentrak by the theaters. Rentrak's business model as a data aggregator and its reputation as a reliable source of revenue information are dependent on its ability to report accurate revenue figures to the distributors. Any misrepresentation or falsification of the data would seriously compromise Rentrak's reputation. Accordingly, Rentrak has a very strong incentive to ensure the accuracy and reliability of its data.

Further, evidence suggests that box office revenue numbers are widely accepted as reliable by the movie industry and are used for business purposes unrelated to futures trading. For example, the Rentrak numbers are used to determine the amount of money that theaters must remit to distributors for the right to exhibit their motion picture. Performance bonuses paid to talent are often based on the distributor's revenue figure for a particular motion picture. Licensing and merchandising contracts often include terms that are based on distributors' revenue figures.

With respect to data collected through the "call-around" process, in which some of the smaller theaters report their revenues to the distributor directly via e-mail or fax, staff verified that there are protections to minimize the likelihood of manipulation whenever authorized personnel of the distributor carry certain larger positions in contracts based upon the distributor's movies. Specifically, as discussed above, MDEX will regularly compare the movie's Rentrak and distributor revenue numbers and perform verification procedures if the distributor numbers are not in accordance with the Rentrak numbers.

Further, parties other than a movie's distributor (competing studios, for example) receive Rentrak data for a movie, lending further transparency and accountability.

In addition, the Commission notes that most contracts that rely on reported commodity prices such as energy and agricultural futures and options rely on underlying pricing data that is obtained through self-reporting or call-around surveys. For instance, many energy contracts rely

on data from commercial index providers who obtain that data in part from conducting surveys of traders. Many agricultural contracts rely on pricing data collected by the U.S. Department of Agriculture or third parties through a variety of means such as phone, fax, e-mail, web-based report submission and surveys. Most of the economic indicators upon which futures and options are based, such as the Consumer Price Index, are based on data collected from surveys.

B. The Rules Adopted by MDEX Properly Address Fair and Equitable Trading and False Reporting Concerns

DCM Core Principle 9 and Designation Criterion 3 together require an exchange to show that its rules ensure fair, equitable and competitive trading.

The Commission has insisted that MDEX adopt a rule that requires entities and individuals who control a film's marketing budget, release date or opening screen number to provide the Exchange with information regarding such decisions whenever that entity or individual holds a position of 1,000 or more contracts. The Commission has responded to the concerns that have been raised by various individuals and parties that a distributor could influence, to some degree, the level of box office revenues for a film by changing a movie's marketing budget, release date or number of screens on which it opens. Concerns were raised whether parties could "intentionally or accidentally" misreport data relevant to the revenue contracts or change the number of theaters that would show the film during the opening weekend. This rule change will permit those entities to utilize this hedge instrument, if they desire, but provide essential transparency to the Exchange, the National Futures Association and the Commission, which all have oversight responsibilities ensuring fair and equitable trading.

While the Commission believes that the opening weekend motion picture revenue numbers are not readily susceptible to manipulation, "false rumors" or misreporting of data may exist in the motion picture industry, just as it does with many other industries. Although such conduct might be a violation under Section 9(a)(2) of the Act (barring false reporting), the

possibility of such rumors or misreporting does not constitute a legal basis to conclude that a proposed futures or options contract would violate the Act.

MDEX Rule 906 (Studio/Distributor Firewall Requirement) requires a motion picture studio or distributor of a motion picture that trades the contract to adopt and enforce firewall procedures prior to the trading of any MDEX contracts on a motion picture that the studio or distributor has released. MDEX also will require each distributor to submit to the Exchange a copy of its firewall procedures prior to being granted access to trade. The Exchange will evaluate the firewall procedures based on the following criteria: (1) physical separation of the groups; (2) separation of reporting lines for each group of at least one management level within the organization; (3) periodic review of the firewall policy for implicated employees; and (4) periodic review and reporting of the adherence to and the effectiveness of the firewall policy. MDEX also will require each distributor to annually attest to the Exchange any updates to the firewall procedures, that compliance with MDEX Rule 906 was included in its internal control review procedures and that no material deficiencies were noted in connection with such a review.

Pursuant to MDEX Rule 907 (Trading by Certain Persons Prohibited), (1) no employee of a distributor who is responsible for the compilation or computation of publicly-disseminated gross box office revenues may trade any motion picture revenue contract on any motion picture released by such distributor for any account; and (2) no company that is retained by any distributor (*i.e.*, Rentrak) to collect motion picture gross box office revenues from theaters for such distributor, and no employee of the company that is retained by any distributor to collect motion picture gross box office revenues from theaters for the distributor company may trade such contracts for their own account or any account. These persons also will be prohibited from disclosing information relating to motion picture gross box office revenues except, as necessary, to carry out their official responsibilities relating to motion picture gross box office revenues.

MDEX will enforce the trading prohibition rule by requiring the distributors that apply to trade on MDEX, to provide the Exchange with a list of its employees that are restricted from trading (Restricted List).

As part of the application process to become an authorized participant, Exchange staff will review the application and cross-reference the applicant's name with the Restricted List to determine whether the applicant is a restricted party under Rule 907. Moreover, Rentrak will provide MDEX with a list of its employees (all to be on the Restricted List) and has adopted an internal policy that prohibits its employees that have been identified to MDEX on the Restricted List from trading on MDEX.

The Commission believes these additional protections agreed to by MDEX satisfy the requirement to ensure that trading in this contract is fair and equitable.

IV. The Proposed Contracts Provide Reasonable Means for Managing Risks Associated With Box Office Revenues

Section 3 of the CEA specifies the Findings and Purpose of the Act. In part, it states that “transactions subject to this Act are entered into regularly in interstate and international commerce and are affected with a national public interest by providing a means for managing and assuming price risks, discovery prices, or disseminating pricing information through trading in liquid, fair and financially secure trading facilities.” Some commenters suggest that Section 3 of the Act establishes an economic purpose standard to be used in evaluating whether a contract should be subject to CFTC jurisdiction. The test advocated by these commenters appears similar to the economic purpose test formerly required by the Commission under Section 5(7) of the Act, which was repealed by Congress in 2000. That economic purpose test was used by the CFTC to evaluate the hedging utility of proposed new contracts.

Since Section 5(7) was repealed, the Commission has not applied an economic purpose test to contract review. As such, the Commission did not adopt an economic purpose test in

determining whether to approve contracts on motion picture gross box office revenues.

Nevertheless, in light of the comments raised by the studios, the Commission evaluated MDEX's proposed contracts to determine whether they would provide some reasonable means for managing risks associated with box office revenues. The Commission found that the contracts can perform hedging and price discovery purposes. Industry profit and losses have a clear and direct relationship to box office revenues. A contract based on those revenues could be used to hedge related risks.

The Commission analysis applied three tests to determine whether or not these contracts could be used by an identifiable segment of an industry or industries for hedging or price basing on more than an occasional basis. First, based on comments from knowledgeable industry participants, there are significant risks faced by many firms in the movie industry. Film production requires a significant amount of upfront capital with long lead times to completion. In addition, film financing can involve pre-selling in the form of office space leases for construction and transactions with foreign distributors or television providers. To deal with the risks associated with film production, the industry has developed various risk-reducing methods, such as buying insurance to cover weather conditions and cast uncertainties or obtaining a bond to guarantee the completion of a film. Information provided through staff discussions with industry sources, as well as through written comments and statements by several participants at the May 19, 2010, hearing, revealed that there are various risks associated with film production that could be hedged with risk management tools. With respect to the flow of capital into the film-making process, one comment letter stated that about \$14 billion in film financing has been provided by third parties since 2004. Studios have increasingly relied on third party financial arrangements through Special Purpose Vehicles and/or securitization to reduce their own commercial exposure. The Commission understands from numerous written comments and from

testimony taken during the May 19 hearing that these third party investors may utilize futures contracts to mitigate their commercial exposure, even if the studios do not.

Second, box office revenue numbers are viewed by the industry as meaningful indicators of the success of a particular film. These numbers are the basis for various contractual arrangements in the industry. In this regard, the reported motion picture revenue numbers are viewed as reliable and accurate summations of actual box office revenues. Industry sources indicate that international distribution decisions, pay television license fees, DVD sales and downstream television revenues are all affected by U.S. box office performance data. U.S. box office revenue numbers are viewed as key variables in this assessment. Moreover, industry sources have indicated that box office revenue numbers are used as the basis for bilateral contracts between producers and persons paid based on gross revenues.

Finally, the Commission has received comment letters or statements at the May Hearing describing the hedging potential for the contracts. Nine commenters either stated their belief that the contracts would provide a risk management tool or expressed interest in using the contracts for hedging. Those commenters stated that direct participants in the motion picture industry, such as studios and producers, may benefit from having motion picture revenue futures contracts. They also stated that parties not directly involved in the motion picture business, such as third party financiers, licensors and merchandisers, might hedge risks associated with motion pictures with which they associate their products and services.

V. Conclusion

Based on the foregoing economic and legal analysis of the MDEX request for contract approval, the Commission does not believe that the terms and conditions of the proposed Weekend Motion Picture Revenue futures and options contracts violate the Act or the Commission's Regulations thereunder. Therefore, the Commission approved the MDEX

Opening Weekend Motion Picture Revenue collared futures contract, binary option contract and the rules applicable thereto pursuant to Section 5c(c)(2) and Section 5c(c)(3) of the CEA and Commission Regulation 40.3.
