This letter is in reference to CME Submission No. 13-379, CFTC Regulation 40.10(a) Advance Notice ("Submission"), dated September 23, 2013, notifying the Commission that CME's New York Data Center will become its primary backup data center.

CME concurrently filed the Submission with the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, pursuant to Regulation 40.10(a)(2). The Division of Clearing and Risk ("Division") has consulted with the Board of Governors regarding the Submission in accordance with Section 806 of Title VIII of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

The Division has completed its review of the Submission. Pursuant to delegated authority under Regulation 40.7(a)(1)(iii), with the concurrence of the General Counsel or the General Counsel's delegate, the Division hereby notifies CME that it does not object to CME's designation of its New York Data Center as its primary backup data center, as described in the Submission, and in the further information provided by CME in response to the Division's November 4 and December 3, 2013 requests pursuant to Regulation 40.10(c), and authorizes implementation of the proposed change on or after December 20, 2013.
