RE: Request for Temporary Registration Under Rule 37.3(c) and Full Registration Under Rule 37.3(b) as a Swap Execution Facility

Dear Secretary Jurgens:

On behalf of my client, BGC Derivatives Markets, L.P. (“BGCDMLP”), I hereby submit this Application for registration as a swap execution facility (“SEF”) pursuant to section 5h of the Commodity Exchange Act, 7 U.S.C. §1 *et seq.*, and Part 37 of the regulations of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“Commission”). BGCDMLP respectfully requests pursuant to Commission Regulation 37.3(c) that the Commission, with this submission, grant BGCDMLP temporary registration as a SEF.

BGCDMLP further requests under Commission Regulation 37.3(b), that the Commission, with this Application, grant BGC full registration as a SEF. BGCDMLP under Regulation 37.3(b)(1)(iii) requests that the Commission issue a unique, extensible, alphanumeric code for the purpose of identifying the SEF pursuant to part 45 of the Commission’s Regulations.

BGCDMLP certifies that an affiliate of BGCDMLP has been operating in reliance upon Commission No-Action Letter 13-28 (June 17, 2013).

BGCDMLP requests that the documents included in this Application and listed in Appendix A to this letter be kept confidential. BGCDMLP has submitted under separate cover to the Assistant Secretary of the Commission for FOI, Privacy and Sunshine Acts Compliance a Petition for Confidential Treatment pursuant to Regulation 145.9(d)(1) with respect to the documents listed in Appendix A.
