**Exhibit R – Rules Prohibiting Specific Trade Practice Violations.**

<b>Rule Number</b>	<b>Rule</b>	<b>Brief Description</b>
503(c)	Trading Hours for Required and Permitted Transactions	It is a violation to make a bid or offer, or to engage in any transaction before or after the Trading Hours of a Swap.
505	Pre-Execution Discussions and Cross Trades	It is a violation to enter through the Trading System a pre-discussed transaction for illegal or improper purpose or knowingly assume the opposite side of own or Customer order (i.e. “cross trade”), unless certain conditions are met.
506(b)	Allocation and Priority of Orders; No Withholding of Orders	It is a violation to withhold or withdraw an order for the benefit of any Customer.
506(c)	Allocation and Priority of Orders; No Withholding of Orders	It is a violation to enter order for own account or account for which you have direct or indirect financial interest when you have an order of a Customer that is capable of being accepted.
507(a)	Prohibited Bids and Offers	It is a violation to enter bid, offer, or transaction when insolvent.
507(b)	Prohibited Bids and Offers	It is a violation to enter bids or offers other than in good faith of executing transactions.
507(c)	Prohibited Bids and Offers	Except for RFQ executions, it is a violation to buy at price higher than lowest available offer or sell at lower price than the highest available bid for cleared swaps by clearinghouse.
508	Orders Required to Be Cleared	It is a violation to place order or execute transaction without written consent of clearing participant, which consent may be in blanket form.
903	No Transfers	It is a violation to transfer or assign trading privileges.
904	False Information	It is a violation to disseminate false, misleading, or knowingly inaccurate information.

905	Manipulation Prohibited	It is a violation to manipulate swap price or corner swap or underlying commodity.
906	Misstatements	It is a violation to furnish false or misleading information, or fail to furnish information, when requested by the Facility.
907	Employees of the Facility	It is a violation to carry an account, enter an order or effect a transaction for an employee of the Facility, Clearing Organization, or other Participant without consent.
908	Abusive Trading Practices Prohibited	It is a violation to engage in front-running, wash trading, pre-arranged trading, fraudulent trading, money passes, or to enter into non-competitive transactions except as allowed by rules, or execute such order for another.
909	Detrimental Conduct	It is a violation to engage in conduct or practices inconsistent with just and equitable principles of trade, or in conduct or practices detrimental to the best interests of the Facility.
