To Whom it May Concern:

Pursuant to Section 5h of the Commodity Exchange Act and Part 37 of the regulations of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC”), Thomson Reuters (SEF) LLC (“TR SEF”) hereby submits this Swap Execution Facility Application. TR SEF respectfully requests that the CFTC grant TR SEF’s application for temporary registration pursuant to CFTC regulation § 37.3(c). TR SEF requests from the CFTC a unique, extensible, alphanumeric code for the purpose of identifying the SEF pursuant to Part 45 of the CFTC’s regulations.

TR SEF has submitted to the Assistant Secretary of the Commission for Freedom of Information a request for confidential treatment of the documents listed on Schedule I hereto. TR SEF requests confidential treatment for these materials pursuant to CFTC regulation § 145.9(d)(1)(ii) because disclosure of such materials would reveal trade secrets and/or confidential commercial or financial information of TR SEF. We request this confidential treatment for an indefinite period.

Pursuant to CFTC regulation § 37.3(c)(1)(ii), TR SEF hereby notifies the CFTC that its affiliate, FX Alliance, LLC, is currently operating as an Exempt Board of Trade pursuant to a notification sent to the Office of the Secretary of the CFTC on July 15, 2011.
