ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING

Having settled this matter in April of this year, the parties filed a written stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). See Stipulation Of Voluntary Dismissal, filed April 25, 2000. They requested that prior to dismissing the case, the Court stay the proceeding until June 30, 2000, to permit the parties to fully perform their settlement agreement. Id. The Court granted the request. See Order Staying Proceeding Pending Full Performance of Settlement Agreement, filed April 25, 2000.

The Court's April 25, 2000 Order stated that if no party requested further proceedings by June 29, 2000, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. <u>See</u> 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
