**ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING**

Having settled this matter in January 2000, complainant Thomas M. Gallagher filed a written stipulation of dismissal. See Stipulation For Dismissal, dated January 26, 2000. The parties, however, requested that prior to dismissing the case, the Court stay the proceeding until July 28, 2000, to permit them to fully perform their settlement agreement. See Agreed Motion to Stay, dated January 26, 2000 ("Agreed Motion"). The Court granted the Agreed Motion. See Order Staying Proceeding Pending Full Performance of Settlement Agreement, dated January 27, 2000.

The Court's January 27, 2000 Order stated that if no party requested further proceedings by July 28, 2000, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety.
