ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 25, 1998, complainant and respondents jointly filed a Stipulation of Settlement. According to the Stipulation, the settlement agreement provided for an initial payment to complainant followed by additional payments over the next seven months. Accordingly, the Court issued an order staying this proceeding to ensure performance under the terms of the agreement. Order Staying Proceedings, dated March 26, 1998.

The Court's March 26, 1998 Order stated that if none of the parties requested further proceedings on or before November 27, 1998, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the Complaint is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety.
