

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

In accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a), the Court has received the parties' stipulation of dismissal of the proceeding. See Letter from Glenn K. Ledford, dated August 24, 2001; Letter from Gary A. Feder, Esq. to the Court, dated August 24, 2001. Therefore, pursuant to 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c), the complaint is **DISMISSED**, and this proceeding is **TERMINATED** in its entirety. This dismissal is with prejudice to complainant's right to re-file a claim in reparations based upon the same set of facts as alleged in the dismissed complaint, but without prejudice to the parties' right to seek redress in such alternative forums as may be available for adjudication of their claims. See 17 C.F.R. §12.21(b).
