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ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING

On May 11, 2000, the parties filed a written stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). Stipulated Order to Stay and to Dismiss, dated May 4, 2000. In the stipulation, they requested that prior to dismissing the case, the Court stay the proceedings until January 26, 2001 to permit the them to partially perform their underlying settlement agreement. Id. The Court granted the request. See Order Staying Proceeding Pending Partial Performance of Settlement Agreement, dated May 12, 2000.

The Court's May 12, 2000 Order stated that if no party requested further proceedings by January 26, 2001, the Court would enter an order of dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. See 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
