

ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING

On October 7, 1998, the parties filed a joint stipulation of dismissal in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). Stipulated Notice of Settlement and Request for Dismissal, filed October 7, 1998 ("Stipulation of Dismissal"). In the Stipulation of Dismissal, the parties requested that the proceeding be stayed, pending full performance of a settlement agreement, which was anticipated to occur by June 1, 1999. Stipulation of Dismissal; Letter From Fred S. Konigsberg to the Court, dated October 7, 1998. The Court entered the requested stay, stating that if no party requested further proceedings by June 22, 1999, the Court would dismiss this case in its entirety. Order Staying Proceedings, dated October 8, 1998. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the complaint and counterclaim are hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and this matter is terminated in its entirety. 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
