
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On June 2, 1998, complainant Marlin M. Plank and respondents Jeffrey Paul Jedlicki, David Scott Marks and Universal Commodity Corporation filed a written stipulation settling this matter, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. §12.21(a). Stipulation of Dismissal, dated June 1, 1998. The corresponding settlement agreement, submitted in camera, provided for payments to complainant to be completed by October 16, 1998, and for dismissal of the Complaint upon full performance. Accordingly, the Court issued an Order staying this proceeding to ensure performance under the terms of the agreement. Order Staying Proceedings and Canceling the Oral Hearing, dated June 4, 1998.

The Court's June 4, 1998 Order stated that if none of the parties requested further proceedings on or before October 23, 1998, the Court would enter the requested Order of Dismissal. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the Complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety. 17 C.F.R. §12.21(c).
