ORDER DISMISSING REPARATION PROCEEDING

In May 1998, the parties filed a Joint Notice of Settlement of this matter. Joint Notice of Settlement, undated, filed May 11, 1998. The settlement called for payments to complainant over a period of 45 days, and for dismissal of the proceeding upon full performance. Letter from Walter A. Bajak, Esq. to the Court, dated May 12, 1998, attaching Settlement Agreement (submitted in camera). Accordingly, the Court issued an Order staying this proceeding to permit performance under the terms of the agreement. Order Staying Proceedings, dated May 12, 1998.

The Court's May 12, 1998 Order stated that if none of the parties requested further proceedings on or before June 30, 1998, the Court would dismiss the Complaint. Accordingly, since there is no such request pending, the Complaint is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice and the matter is terminated in its entirety.
