DEFAULT ORDER AS TO RESPONDENT CMB CAPITAL MANAGEMENT CORP. and ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO RESPONDENT SWISS FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC.

Default Order: Respondent CMB Capital Management Corp. (CMB) has not filed an answer to the complaint. Accordingly, that firm is in default and is deemed to have waived its right to challenge the allegations of the complaint, to select a level of proceeding, to file affirmative defenses, or to present evidence in its own behalf. See Rule 12.22.

Based solely on the allegations of the complaint, it is determined that CMB committed numerous violations of Section 4b of the Commodity Exchange Act by failing to inform complainant of material facts relating to margin information regarding his account. The following award represents the amount claimed in the complaint. Payment of the reparation award will be in the amount ordered, less any amounts received in settlement by complainant from respondent Swiss Financial Services, Inc.

Violations having been found, IT IS ORDERED that respondent CMB Capital Management Service Corp. shall pay reparations to the complainant in the amount of \$23,585.35 plus prejudgment interested compounded annually on that amount at the rate of 5.407% from April 25, 1997, to the date of payment, plus \$125.00 in costs.

Order of Dismissal: Pursuant to the stipulation signed by the complainant's attorneys and respondent Swiss Financial Services' attorneys, which expressly encompasses the counterclaim filed by Swiss, the proceeding is DISMISSED as to Swiss Financial Services, Inc., only.

All other motions pending in this proceeding are DENIED as moot.
