ORDER VACATING STAY ORDER

In this proceeding under the Commodity Exchange Act (7 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*), an order was issued October 9, 1964, suspending respondent's registration as a floor broker for a period of 10 days and ordering all contract markets to refuse all trading privileges to respondent during such period. Respondent filed an appeal of the order of October 9, 1964, in the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit and on October 19, 1964, the order of October 9, 1964, was stayed pending the outcome of respondent's appeal. On May 18, 1965, the Court affirmed the order of October 9, 1964. Accordingly, the stay order of October 19, 1964, is hereby vacated and the suspension of respondent's registration as a floor broker under the act and the order to all contract markets to refuse him all trading privileges, both for a period of 10 days, contained in the order of October 9, 1964, shall be effective October 4, 1965.

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
