ORDER DESIGNATING THE MEMPHIS MERCHANTS EXCHANGE
CLEARING ASSOCIATION AS A CONTRACT MARKET FOR
COTTONSEED MEAL AND SOYBEAN MEAL UNDER THE COMMODITY
EXCHANGE ACT

UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE,
OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY.

Pursuant to the authorization and direction contained
in the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. and Sup.
V, secs. 1-17a), and as further amended by the act of Congress,
approved October 9, 1940 (Public Law No. 818, 76th Cong.), I,

Claude R. Wickard, Secretary of Agriculture, do
hereby designate the Memphis Merchants Exchange Clearing
Association, of Memphis, Tennessee, as a contract market for
cottonseed meal and soybean meal under the Commodity Exchange
Act, as amended, effective December 8, 1940, said association
having applied for, and having otherwise complied with the
conditions imposed by said act precedent to, such designation.
Said designation is subject hereafter to suspension or
revocation in accordance with the provisions of said act.
