Re: **Change in Trading Hours -  
Submission Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Act and Regulation 40.6**

Dear Ms. Donovan:

Pursuant to Section 5c(c)(1) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended, and Commission Regulation 40.6, the Board of Trade of the City of New York, Inc. ("Exchange") submits, by written certification, a change in the electronic trading hours for Sugar No. 14.

In a Submission dated February 7, 2007 (Submission No. 07-6), the Exchange notified the Commission that, commencing on February 20, 2007, the electronic trading hours would be expanded for all Commodity Contracts except FCOJ. After reconsideration, the Exchange will not be expanding the electronic trading hours for its Sugar No. 14 futures contract. Commencing on February 20, 2007, the electronic trading hours for FCOJ and Sugar No. 14 will remain at 7:00 AM – 3:15 PM with the pre-open trading session beginning at 6:45 AM. Commencing on February 20, 2007, the electronic trading hours for Cocoa, Coffee "C"<sup>®</sup>, Cotton No. 2<sup>SM</sup> and Sugar No. 11<sup>SM</sup> will be 1:30 AM – 3:15 PM with the pre-open trading session beginning at 8:00 PM the day prior to the trade date and continuing until 1:30 AM on the trade date.

The change in the trading hours was made in accordance with a Resolution adopted by the Board on February 15, 2007 delegating the authority to change the hours to the Senior Vice President of Market Development, after consultation with senior management.

The Exchange certifies that the change in trading hours complies with the requirements of the Commodity Exchange Act and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. No substantive opposing views were expressed by members or others with respect to the change.
