Dear Ms. Donovan:

Pursuant to Commission Regulation 40.6(a), the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT[®]) hereby submits the following revised option expiration schedule for Agricultural and Financial options:

- **Change the last trading day/expiration for December 2010 agricultural and financial options from Friday, November 26 to Tuesday, November 23, 2010.**

The referenced agricultural options include Corn, Soybean, Soybean Oil, Soybean Meal, Oat, Rice and Wheat contracts. The referenced financial options include U.S. Treasury Bond and 10-Year, 5-Year and 2-Year U.S. Treasury Note contracts. There is no open interest in any of the referenced contracts.

This revision to the option expiration schedule is designed to minimize holiday-related scheduling issues in connection with the 2010 Thanksgiving holiday.

There were no opposing views concerning this change.

The CBOT certifies that this change conforms with the Commodity Exchange Act and the rules thereunder.
