Re: Extension of Initial Review Period of NYMEX Submission No. 26-370 and Submission No. 26-370S for an Additional 45-Days.

Dear Ms. Guilfoile:

This letter is to inform you that, pursuant delegated authority under Commission Regulation 40.7, the Division of Market Oversight (“Division”) has, pursuant to Commission Regulation 40.3(c)(2), determined to extend the review period for New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc., (“NYMEX”) Submission No. 26-370¹ and Submission No. 26-370S² (the “Submission”) regarding NYMEX’s Proposed Silicon Data H100 Rental Index Futures and Silicon Data B200 Rental Index Futures contracts (the “Products”), for additional 45 days after the conclusion of the initial 45-day review period. This determination is based upon the need for additional time to analyze the Products in light of novel or complex issues.

The Commission is presently examining, through a pending Request for Comment, the factors that a designated contract market (“DCM”) should consider when addressing certain provisions of the Commodity Exchange Act and CFTC regulations thereunder that are relevant to the listing for trading of derivatives with compute as the underlier.³

Therefore, the initial review period for the Submission is hereby extended for an additional 45 days, until the end of November 9, 2026.
