LCH Limited Self Certification: Weekly Notification of Connectivity Fee Amendment

Dear Mr Kirkpatrick

Please accept this notification of amendments to LCH Limited's website pursuant to CFTC regulation §40.6(d), for the following non-substantive fee changes.

In order to receive operational reports from LCH, Clearing Members must have appropriate communication links. There are one-off and ongoing costs to Clearing Members associated with this technical connectivity.

Effective 1 April 2020, a 5% fee increase will apply. The increase reflects changes to the technology costs associated with improving resiliency, quality and performance of the connectivity service. A new fee grid has been published on the LCH website, ahead of the implementation of the changes.

The changes to the relevant section of the LCH Limited's website page are included in Appendix I in black line form.

b. Connectivity

To receive operational reports from the Clearing House, members must have appropriate direct or indirect communications links.

The Clearing House provides direct links, typically 2 x 2MB leased lines. The one-off and ongoing costs to members are as quoted in each instance by the telecommunications supplier, such as BT. These costs will vary according to capacity, configuration, member's location and building infrastructure.

Alternative VPN connections may be possible in some cases: these are provided by the relevant supplier. The Clearing House will charge for implementation support of such VPN links on an individual quotation basis.

Members may also link indirectly to receive Clearing House reports via their communications links to CREST and/or Euronext.liffe.

- The Platinum, Gold and Silver tiers can be used for both production and test purposes
