To Whom It May Concern:

By electronic portal dated today, August 17, 2020, NEX SEF Limited (“NEX SEF”) submitted a supplemental rule certification filing (Submission No. 20-364S) to the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (“CFTC” or “Commission”) pursuant to Commission Regulation 40.6 to certify Revisions to NEX SEF’s Limited Form SEF to reflect that it proposes to change its Regulatory Service Provider from the National Futures Association to Chicago Mercantile Exchange Inc. and New York Mercantile Exchange, Inc. (“Revisions”). This supplemental filing includes Appendices A through I.

NEX SEF requests confidential treatment of Appendices A through I (“Confidential Information”), on the grounds that Appendices A through I contain confidential commercial information of the submitter (NEX SEF). NEX SEF requests that confidential treatment be maintained for Appendices A through I until further notice from NEX SEF. We also request that the Commission notify the undersigned immediately after receiving any FOIA request for said Appendices A through I or any other court order, subpoena, or summons for same. Finally, we request that we be notified in the event the Commission intends to disclose such Appendices A through I to Congress or to any other governmental agency or unit pursuant to Section 8 of the CEA. NEX SEF does not waive its notification rights under Section 8(f) of the CEA with respect to any subpoena or summons for such Appendices A through I.
